

SECOND ANGLO-AFGHAN WAR 1878

Second Anglo-Afghan War between the British forces and the Afghan forces, and fought in the Battle of Ali Masjid at the western end of the Khyber Pass on the border between Afghanistan and India on 21st November 1878 under Lieutenant-General Sir Samuel James Browne.
